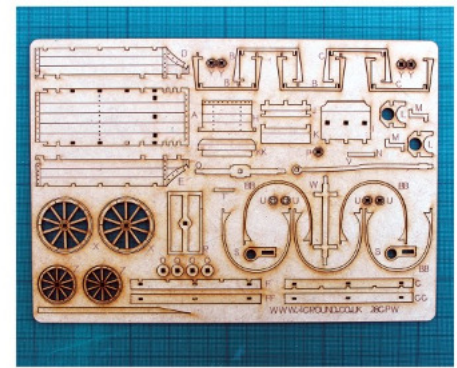


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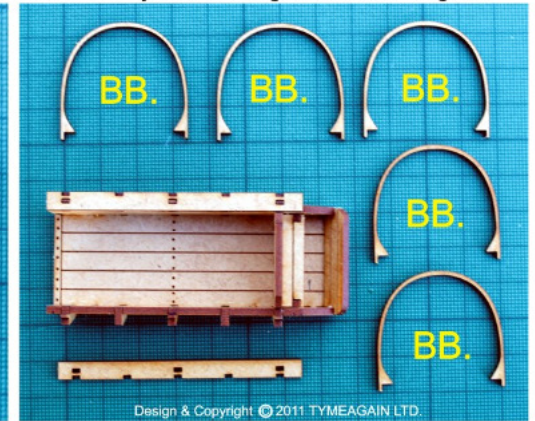
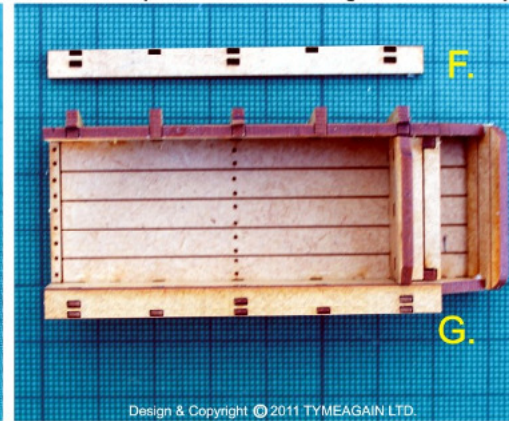
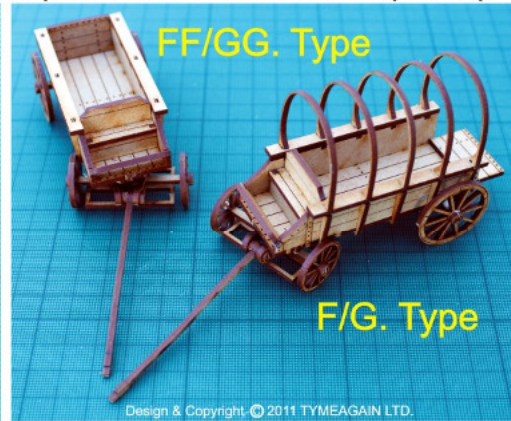
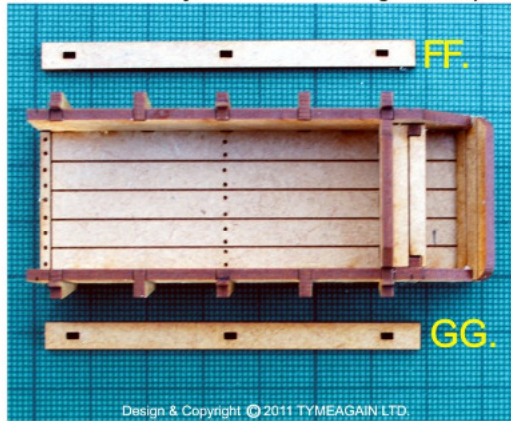
GP Wagon (part 2) General Purpose Wagon 28GPW



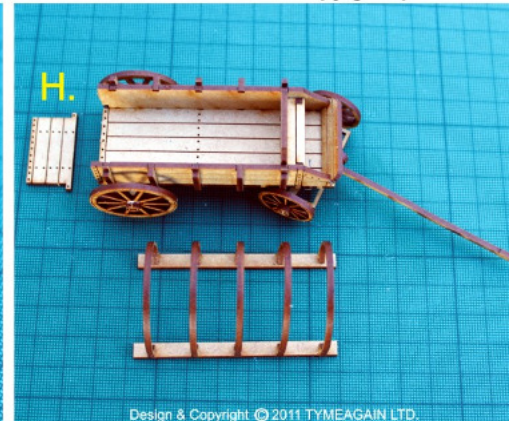
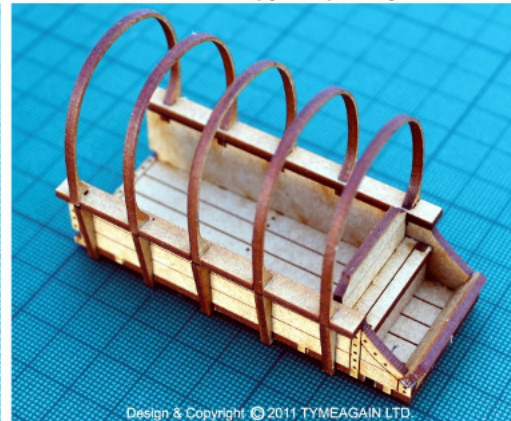
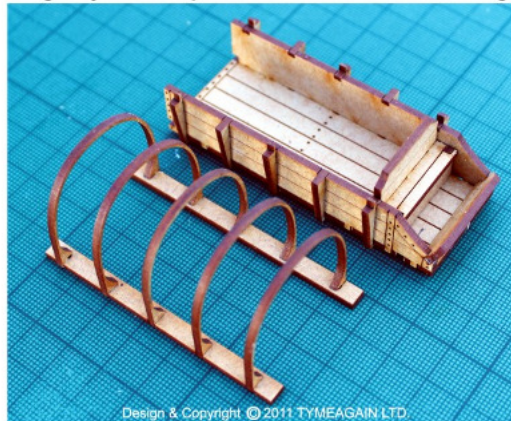
NOTICE: Before assembling your model kit, ensure you have read these instructions. For assembly you will need PVA glue or another suitable adhesive (for joining plywood and other wood composite fibre boards) and a sharp modelling knife is recommended to ease parts from the sprues (remember to cut away from your body and fingers). Sand paper can be used to clean sprue joints.

The 4G difficulty rating for this model kit is level 4. It is not a toy, it is not meant for those under 14yrs.

Before each task you will see an image of the parts required and their letter. Remove all parts required from their sprues before starting that task. All parts will ideally be fitted together with PVA glue.



We give you two options for the finish of this wagon, with and without canopy hoops. If you wish to make the model with out a canopy glue parts GG and FF as shown in the first image above. If you wish to



make the canopy hoop option the railboards needed are parts F and G. Glue all five parts BB to the railboard at the same time you glue the railboards to the wagon body. This model is now finished, a good example of as a general purpose wagon ideal for any period from the C16th right through to the C19th and early C20th, and any country from South Africa to Mid West America or Australia to Austria. It is not a model of the General Service Wagon that was used by British Empire troops from the late 1880's to the 1930's (and a bit beyond), that wagon is to be another kit.
