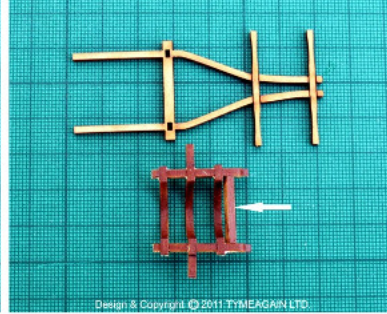
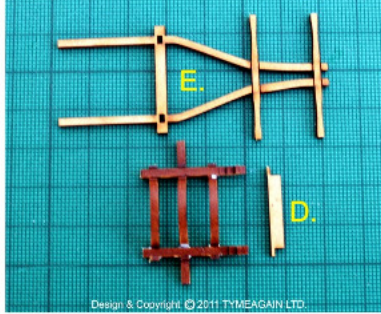
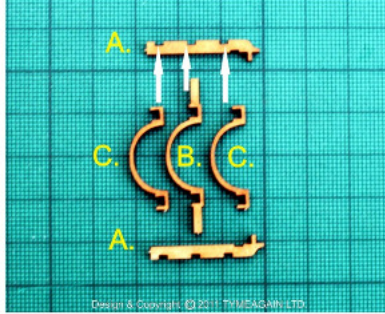
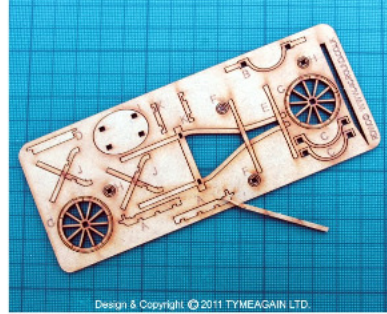
Hand Drawn Water Cart Rorke's Drift Water Cart. 28 RDWC



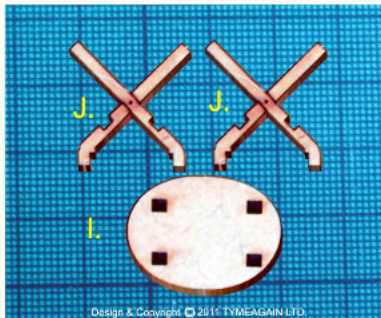
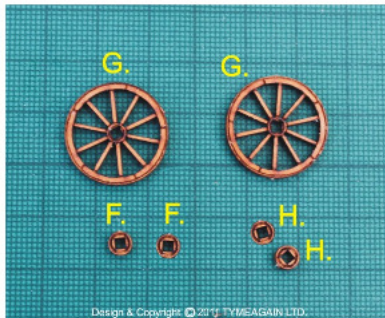
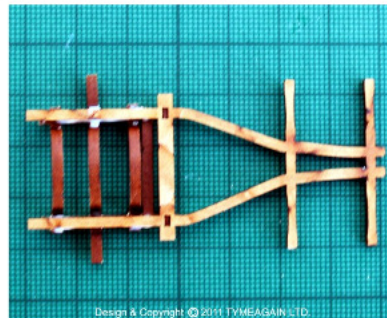
The 4G difficulty rating for this model kit is level 3. It is not a toy, it is not meant for those under 14yrs.

NOTICE: Before assembling your model kit, ensure you have read these instructions. For assembly you will need PVA glue or another suitable adhesive (for joining plywood and other wood composite fibre boards) and a sharp modelling knife is recommended to ease parts from the sprues (remember to cut away from your body and fingers). Sand paper can be used to clean sprue joints.

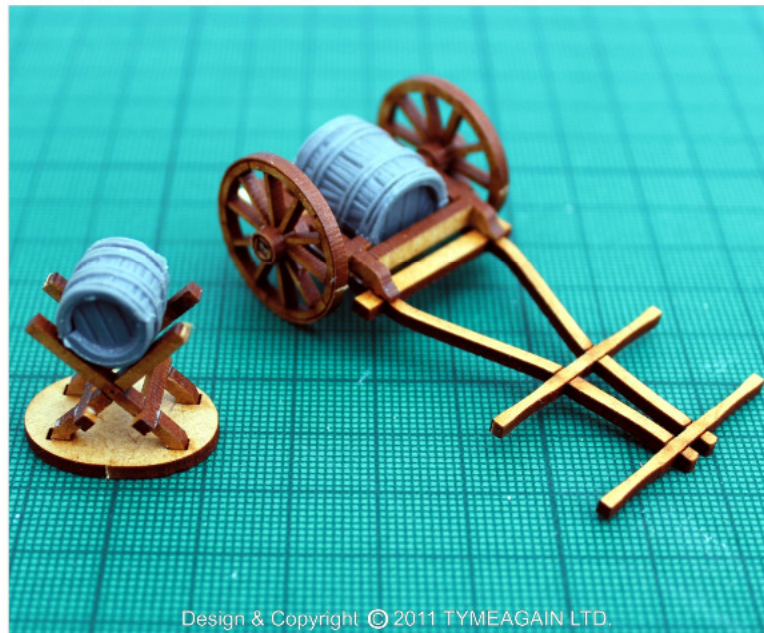
Before each task you will see an image of the parts required and their letter. Remove all parts required from their sprues before starting that task. All parts will ideally be fitted together with PVA glue.



First remove the applicator (this is ideal for pushing parts out from the sprue once they have been cut loose) from the sprue. Glue parts C and B to part A as shown, now glue part D to this assemblage



(the applicator is also good for removing excess glue). Now glue all to part E and leave to dry. Once dry glue parts F to each end of B then add parts G to each end and finish this with gluing parts H to the very end of B, You now have your water cart. Glue parts J to part I as shown in the image directly above this text. Now glue the spacer parts K to each of the parts J, you now have your barrel jack.
