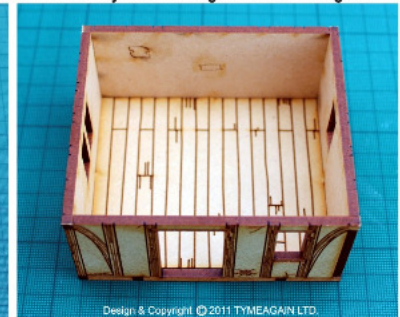
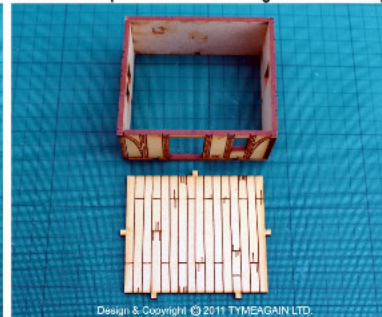
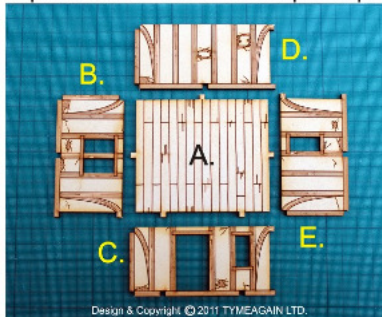
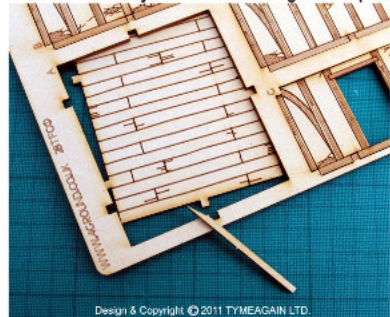
Timber Framed Cottage 28 TFC



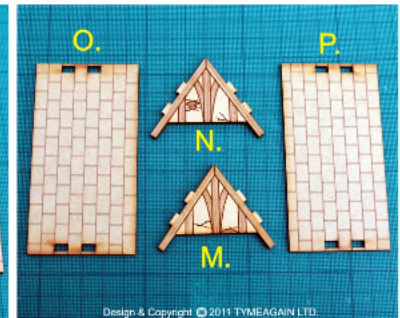
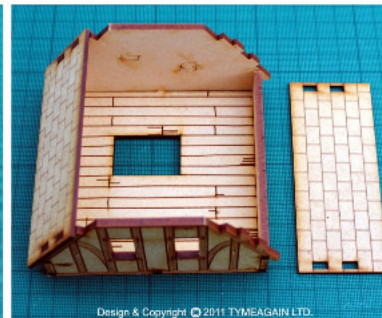
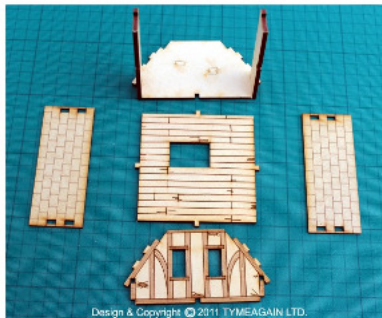
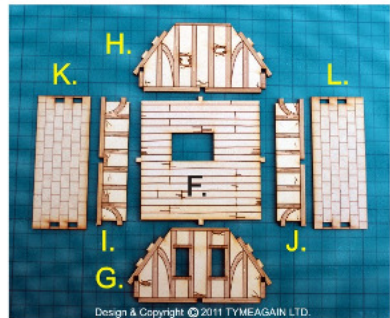
NOTICE: Before assembling your model kit, ensure you have read these instructions. For assembly you will need PVA glue or another suitable adhesive (for joining plywood and other wood composite fibre boards) and a sharp modelling knife is recommended to ease parts from the sprues (remember to cut away from your body and fingers). Sand paper can be used to clean sprue joints.

The 4G difficulty rating for this model kit is level 3. It is not a toy, it is not meant for those under 14yrs.

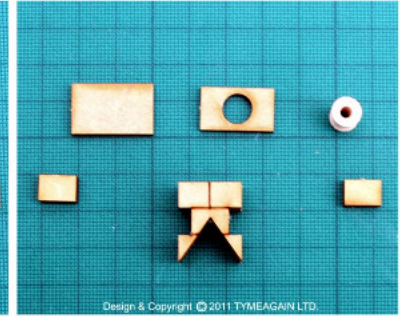
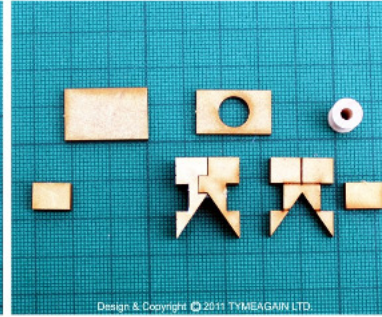
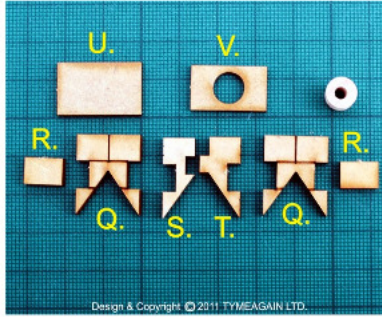
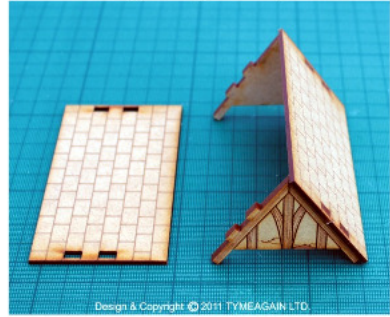
Before each task you will see an image of the parts required and their letter. Remove all parts required from their sprues before starting that task. All parts will ideally be fitted together with PVA glue.



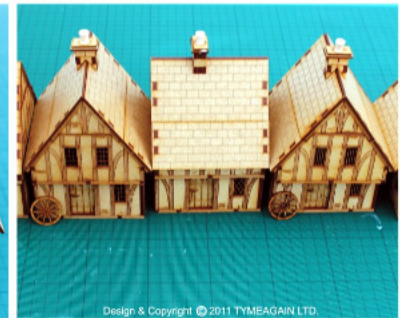
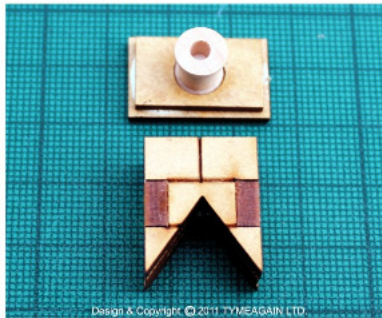
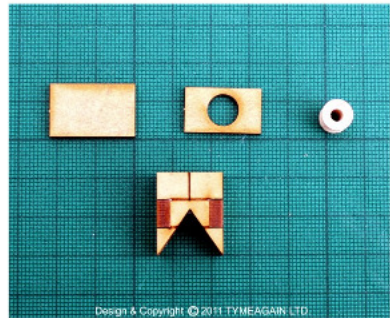
First remove the applicator (this is ideal for pushing parts out from the sprue once they have been cut loose) from the sprue. Parts E and B are interchangeable; Glue parts C to B and E and then glue D



to this assemblage, now glue all to part A. Parts I and J are interchangeable, so are parts G and H; glue parts I and J to part H (the applicator is also good for removing excess glue), now glue all to part G



and base this on part F. Glue part O to parts M and M now glue this to part P. The chimney is an option if required; glue parts S and T to one of parts Q, now glue second part Q and sandwich parts R to



each side on the stack. There are three options now, just glue the pot to the top of the stack, or glue part V to the stack first, or glue part U to V and glue in the pot, then glue this assemblage to the pot as shown in the image above. You may wish to have windows and a door to this cottage (also a locator reduce movement of the levels in play). There are three options for this cottage. medieval - wooden mullioned - windows and door, Tudor - diamond - windows and door and Stuart - small squared - windows and door.
